MOST URGENT

This matter before you, #336/18, has the ability to be used to stop intentionally setup or faked Chemical Weapons Attacks by Western Forces and Britain and France, to justify mass invasion and attacks of Syria to control the Oil under Damascus.

- 1) The Matter actually pertains to a number of Rome Statute Signatories, including Australia, Brazil, Canada, The EU (including Great Britain both pre and post BREXIT), Japan, South (Republic of) Korea, and South Africa, and has been going on since 1999. As such there is both History and Grounds for intervention into this matter without delay. Further, the Defendants should be amended to include the Nations of Australia, Brazil, Canada, The EU, Japan, South (Republic of) Korea, and South Africa.
- 2) The fraud and Appropriation under §8(2)(b)(iv) by those nations, Australia, Brazil, Canada, The EU, Japan, South (Republic of) Korea, and South Africa, which includes Great Britain, functionally impugns the ability of the UN Security Council to sustain a veto-rich environment. Leaving only Russia and China capable of issuing vetos in any matter pertaining to War Crimes using this material in any form, against any nations.
- 3) The impending Syrian Chlorine Attack which Russia and other Intelligence Entities have documented by the West is a key attack against the sovereignty of this Court, the Rome Statute, and the UN Security Council as well as the Articles of the UN Charter and those controlling the International Court of Justice, as they pertain to Appropriation War Crimes.
- 4) The use of Chemical Weapons to stage an attack against Syria to justify an invasion by the West to complete the occupation and seizure of the massive Oil Reserves under Damascus is not only a discrete War Crime, it is a breach of the Chemical Weapons Treaties all parties are signatures to.
- 5) While the US is not a signatory to the ICC's Rome Statute, which it has done to prevent the authority of this court being applied to its crimes, this court has unique capabilities in issuing orders preventing Britain and France as well as all other Rome Statute Signatories from participating with any US insituted Chemical Weapons Attacks against the people of Syria.
- 6) Finally, this court can in fact issue immediate guidance to Rome Statute Nations pertaining to their roles in such matters as well as demanding a response from these Nations (Australia, Brazil, Canada, The EU, Japan, South (Republic of) Korea, and South Africa, including Great Britain) as to how they address the issues pertaining to the US6370629 Patent Frauds as shown in the following Table.
